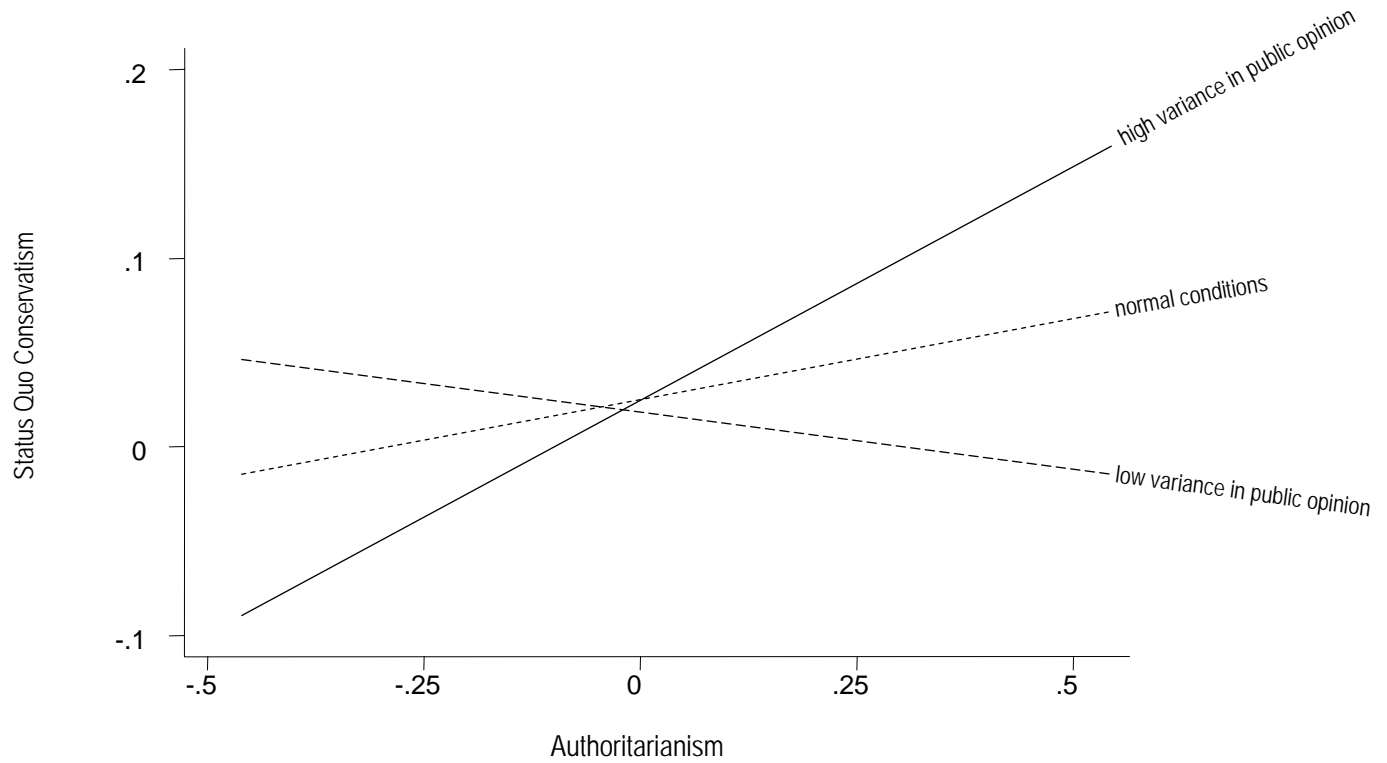


Figure E.1: Effects of Authoritarianism on Status Quo Conservatism

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# Figure E.2: Relationship Between Authoritarianism and Status Quo Conservatism Given Varying Experience of Normative Threat

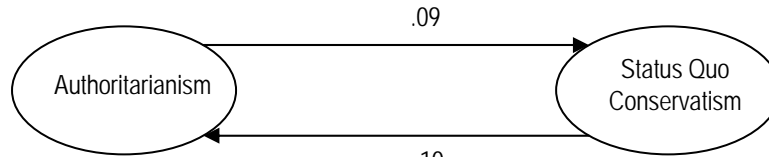


Figure E.2.1: Under normal conditions

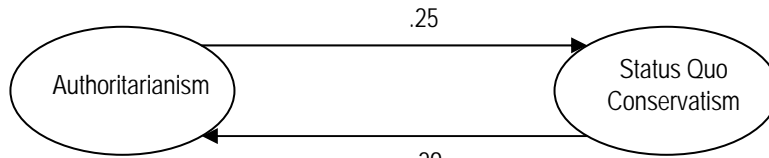


Figure E.2.2: If high variance in public opinion

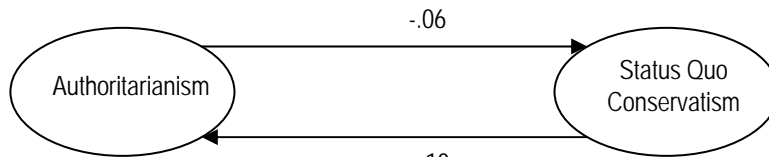


Figure E.2.3: If low variance in public opinion

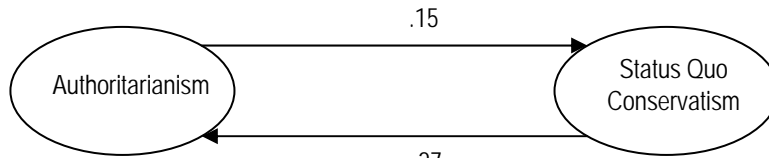


Figure E.2.4: If little confidence in institutions

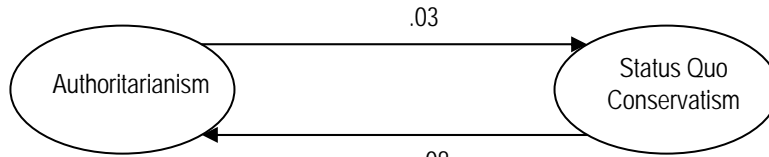


Figure E.2.5: If great confidence in institutions
